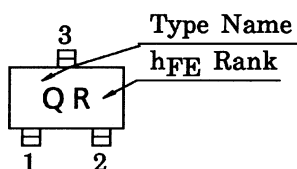

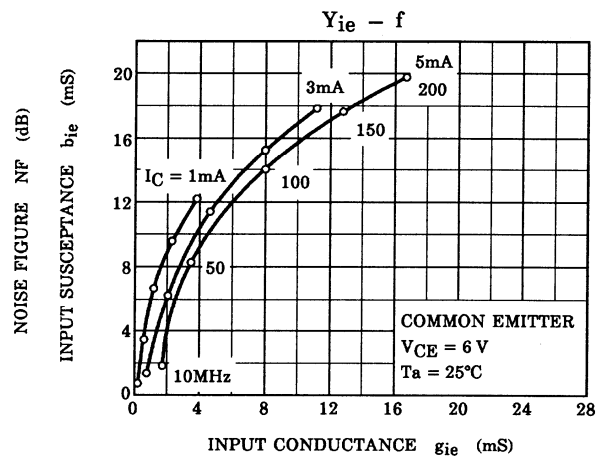
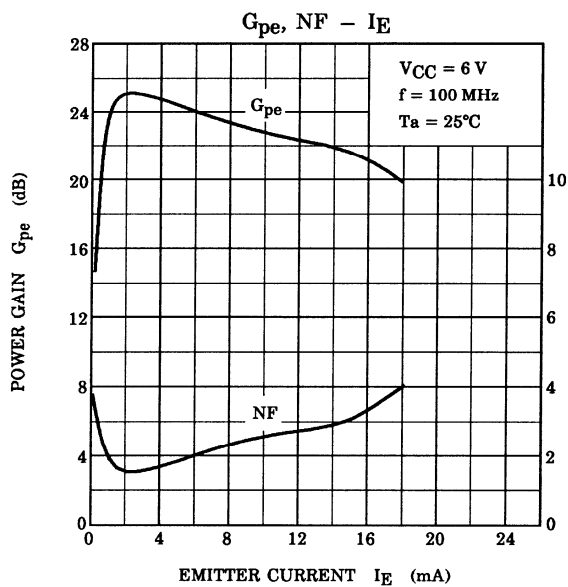
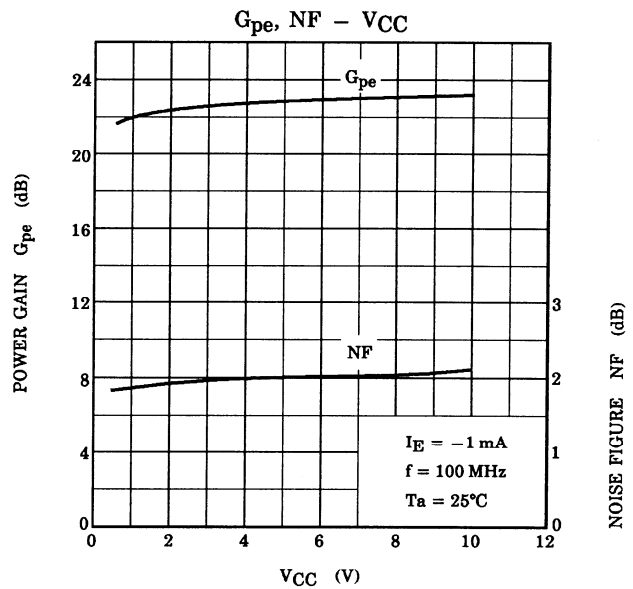
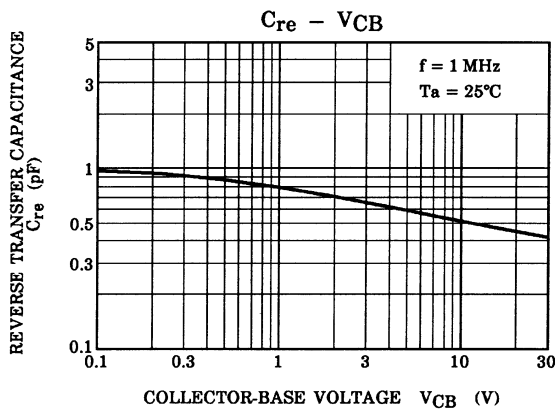
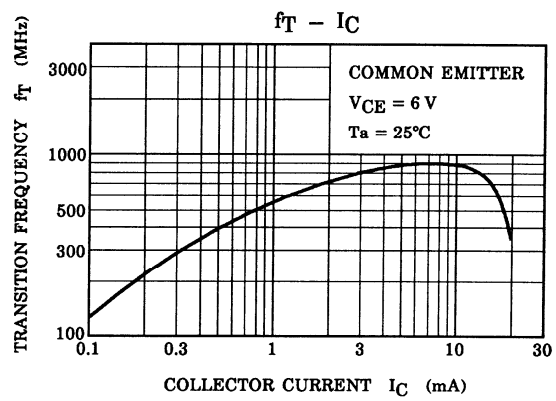
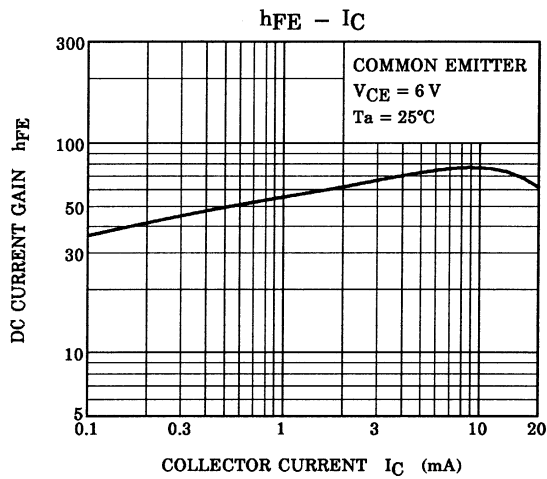


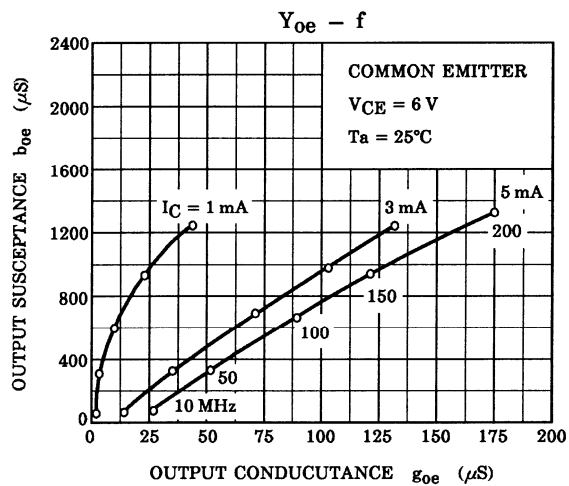
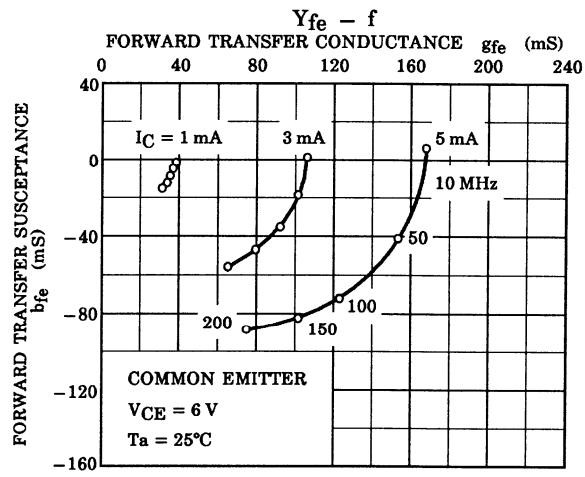
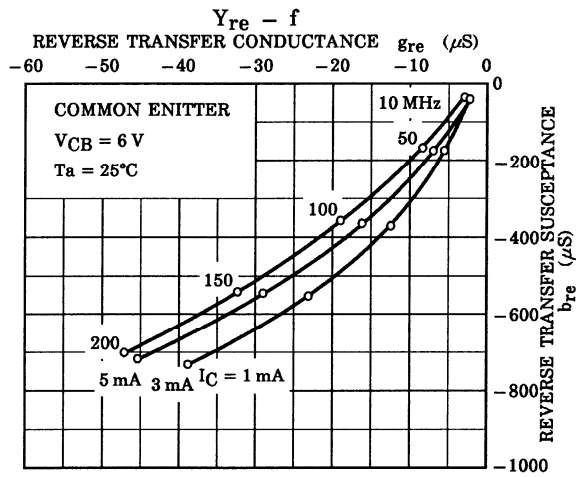
L₁: 0.8 mm ϕ silver plated copper wire, 4 T, 10 mm ID, 8 mm length
