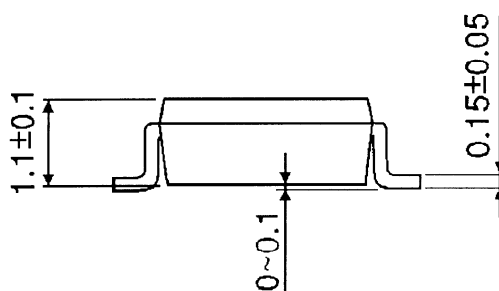
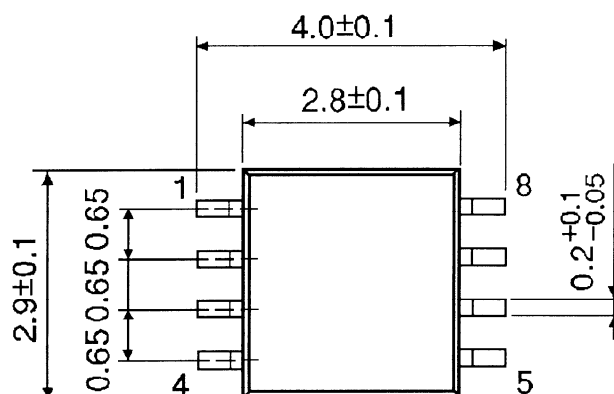
Equivalent Circuit
