For the electronic measurement of currents: DC, AC, pulsed..., with galvanic isolation between the primary circuit and the secondary circuit.

A protective housing or additional shield could be used.


Main supply must be able to be disconnected.

Mechanical characteristics

- General tolerance

Recommended fastening torque 4.7 Nm

- Primary through-hole
- Connection of secondary Recommended fastening torque 2.2 Nm
- ± 1 mm
- 4 slots Ø 6.5 mm
- 4 steel screws M6
- Ø 42 mm
 - M5 threaded studs

Faston 6.3 x 0.8 mm

Remarks

- I_s is positive when I_p flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100°C.
- Dynamic performances (di/dt and response time) are best with a single bar completely filling the primary hole.
