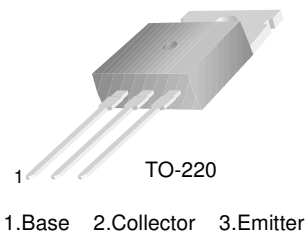

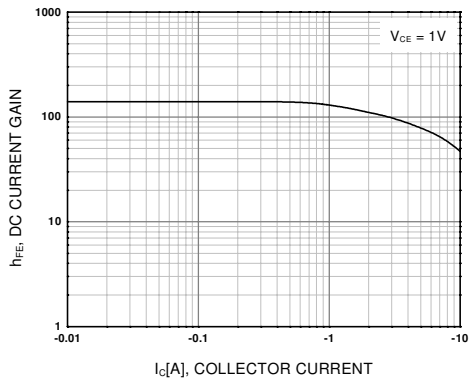


Figure 1. DC current Gain

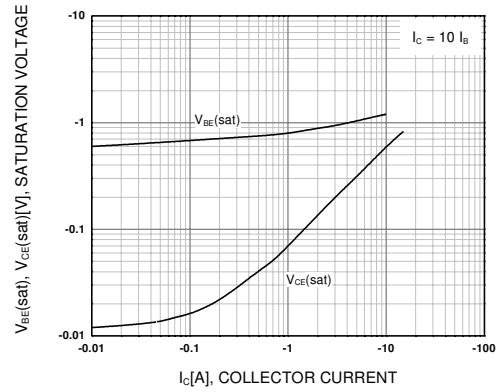


Figure 2. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

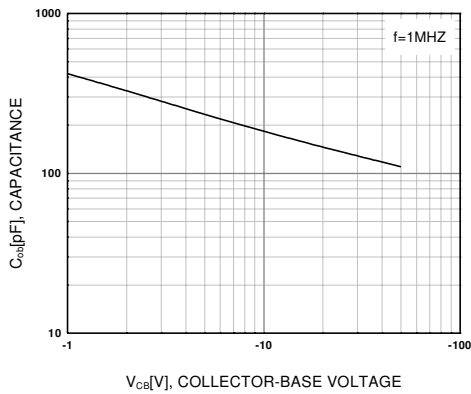


Figure 3. Collector Output Capacitance

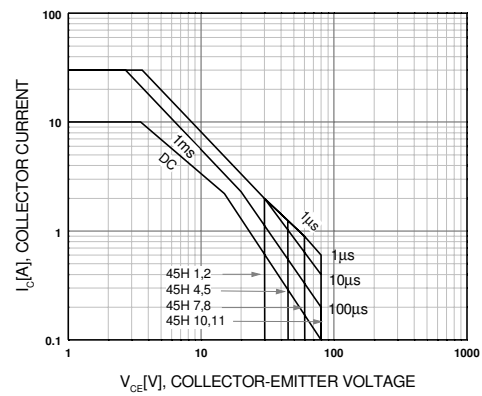


Figure 4. Safe Operating Area

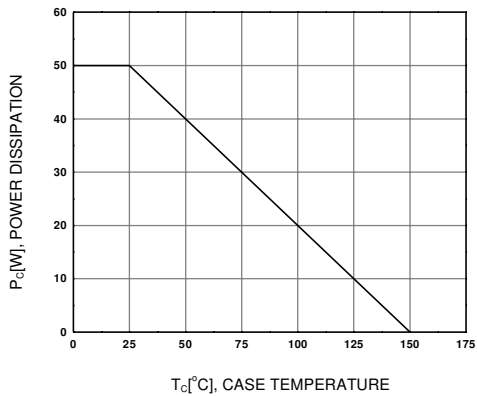
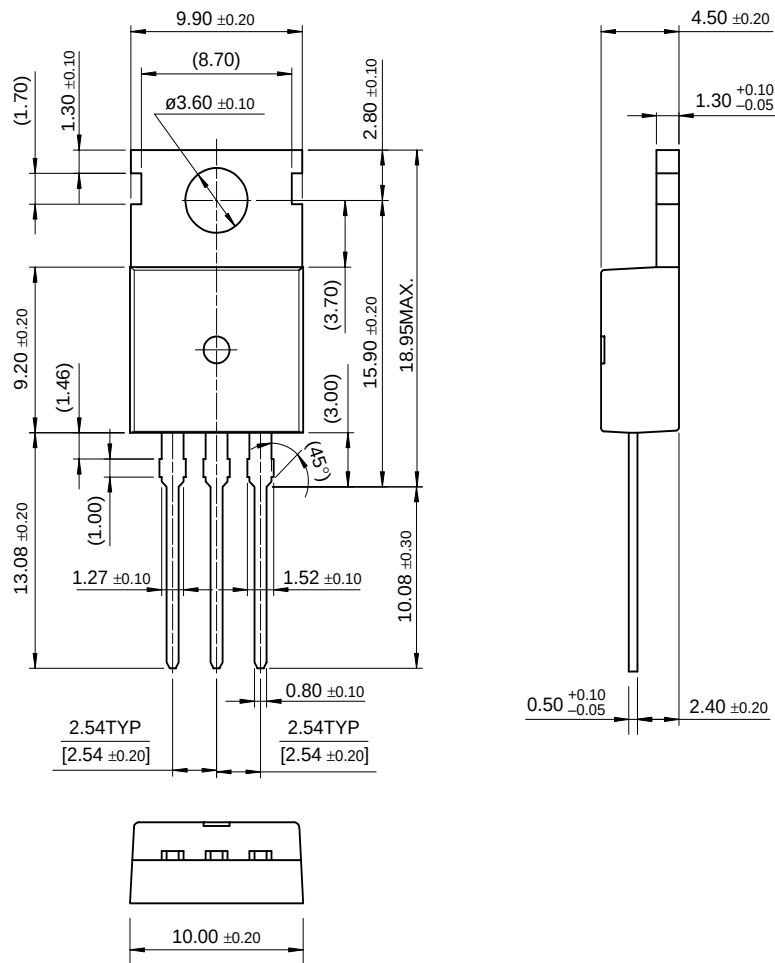


Figure 5. Power Derating
