The NP35N04YLG is N-channel MOS Field Effect Transistor designed for high current switching applications.

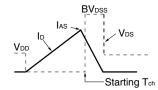

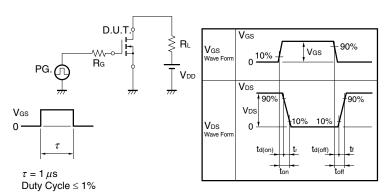

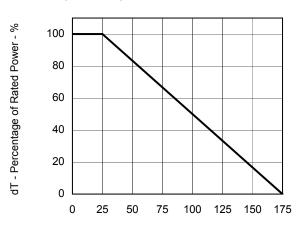
#### **TEST CIRCUIT 2 SWITCHING TIME**

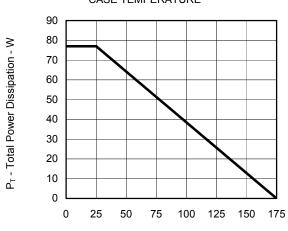

DERATING FACTOR OF FORWARD BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA



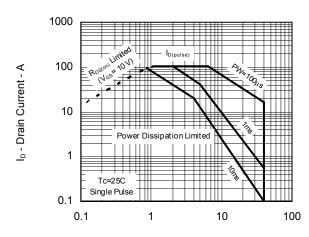

# TOTAL POWER DISSIPATION vs. CASE TEMPERATURE



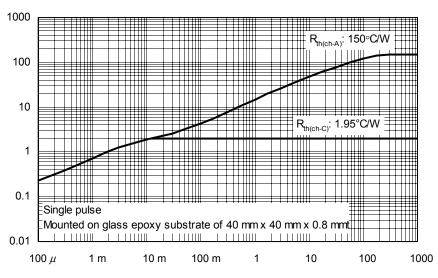

#### TRANSIENT THERMAL RESISTANCE vs. PULSE WIDTH



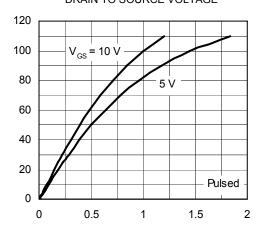

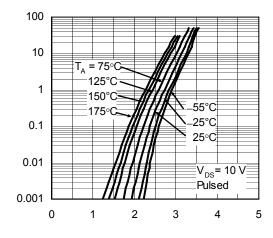

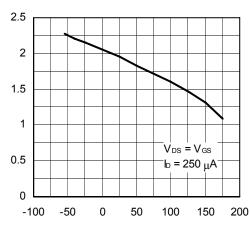

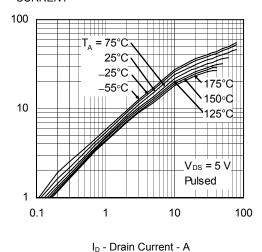

# GATE TO SOURCE THRESHOLD VOLTAGE vs. CHANNEL TEMPERATURE



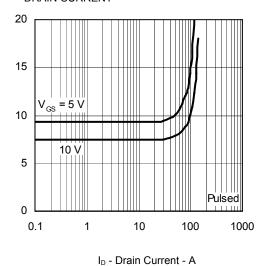

# FORWARD TRANSFER ADMITTANCE vs. DRAIN CURRENT

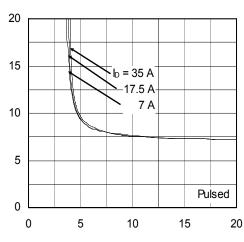


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DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. DRAIN CURRENT



DRAIN TO SOURCE ON-STATE RESISTANCE vs. GATE TO SOURCE VOLTAGE

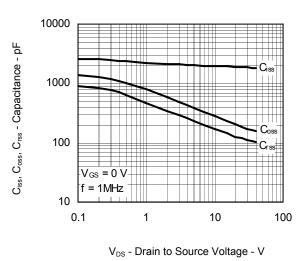

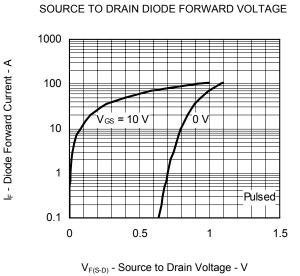

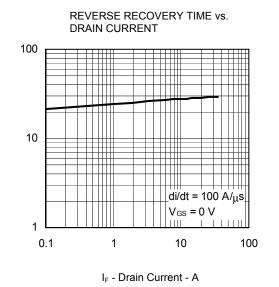


CAPACITANCE vs. DRAIN TO SOURCE VOLTAGE







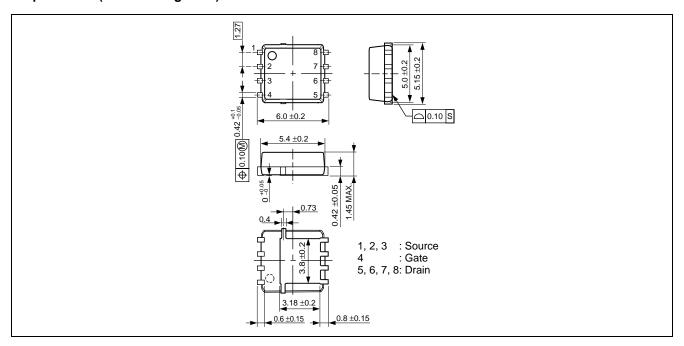

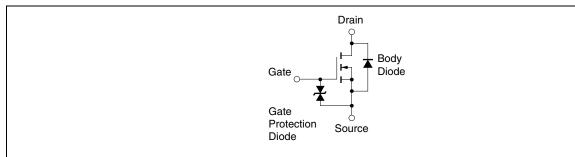

## **Equivalent Circuit**



**Remark** The diode connected between the gate and source of the transistor serves as a protector against ESD. When this device actually used, an additional protection circuit is externally required if a voltage exceeding the rated voltage may be applied to this device.
