

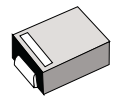

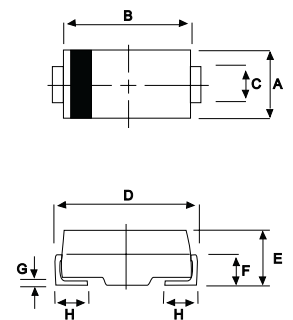

FIG-1 TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

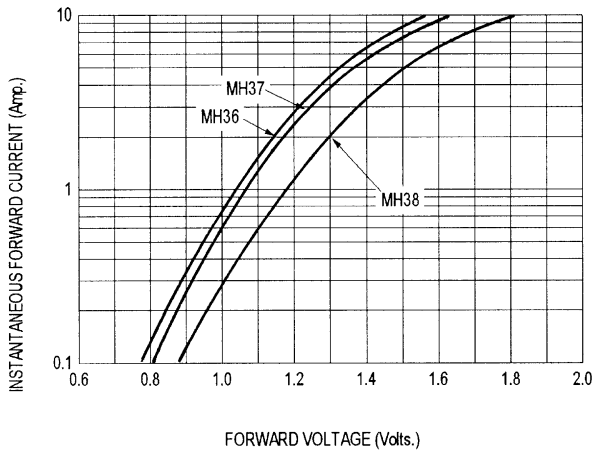


FIG-2 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

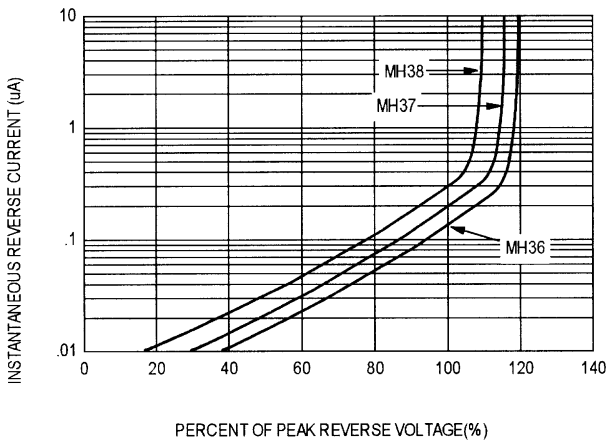


FIG-3 FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

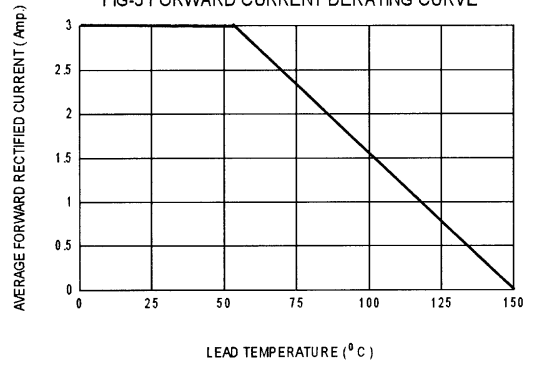


FIG-4 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

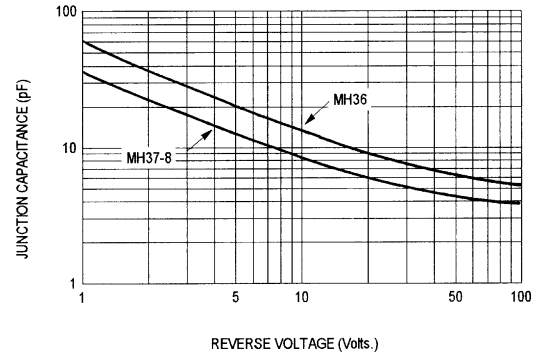
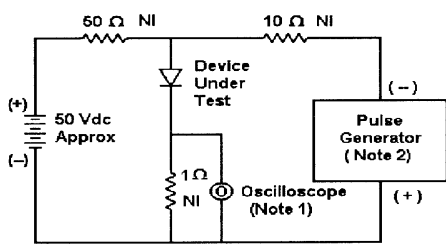
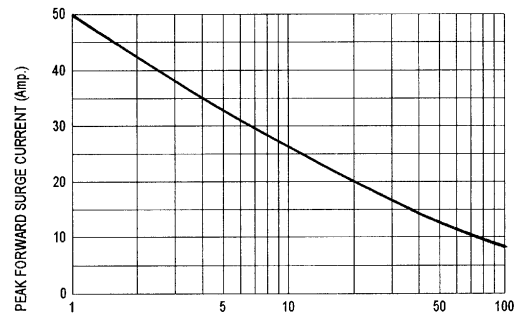
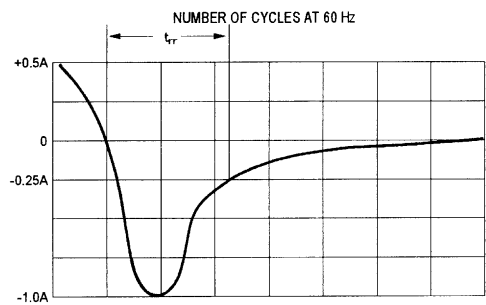


FIG-5 PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
