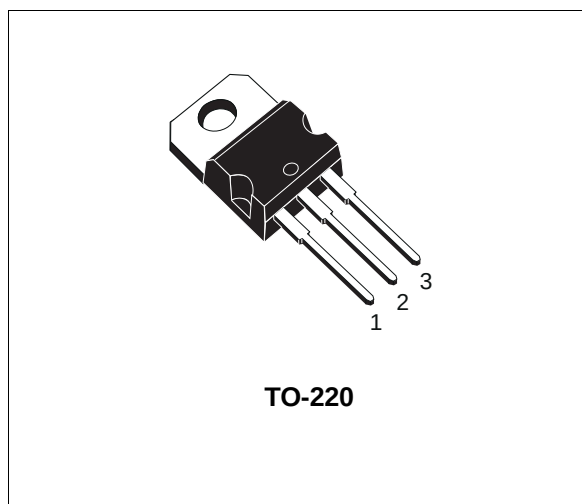

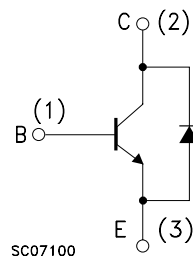
DESCRIPTION

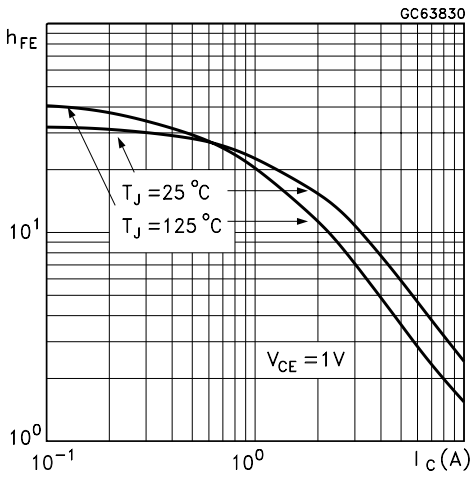

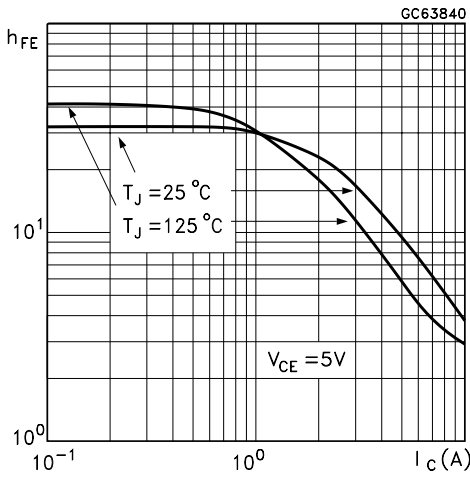
Derating Curve



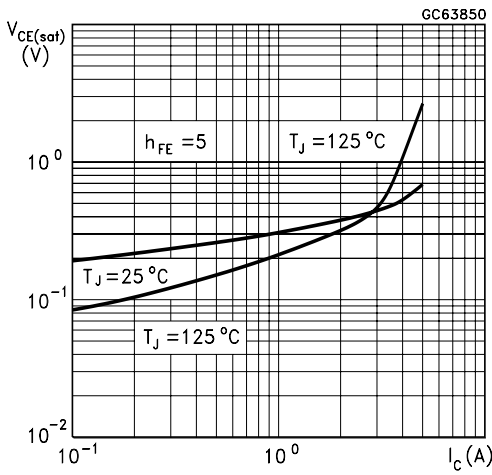
DC Current Gain



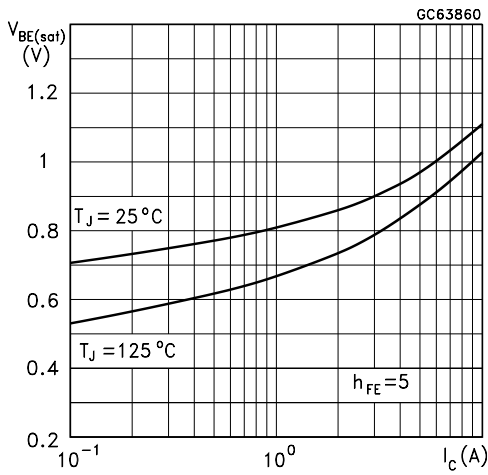
DC Current Gain



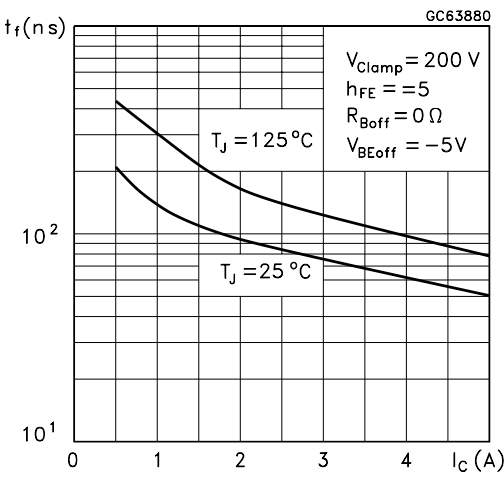
Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage



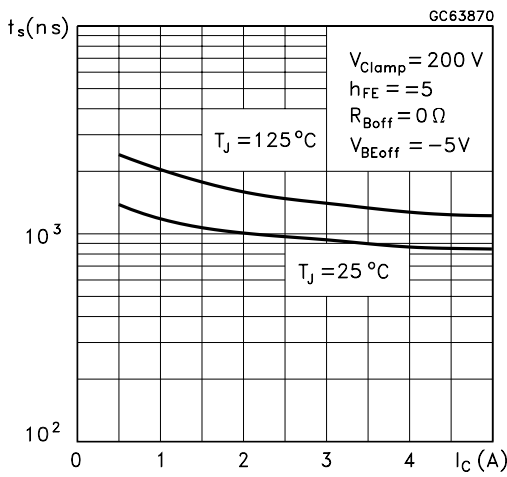
Base Emitter Saturation Voltage



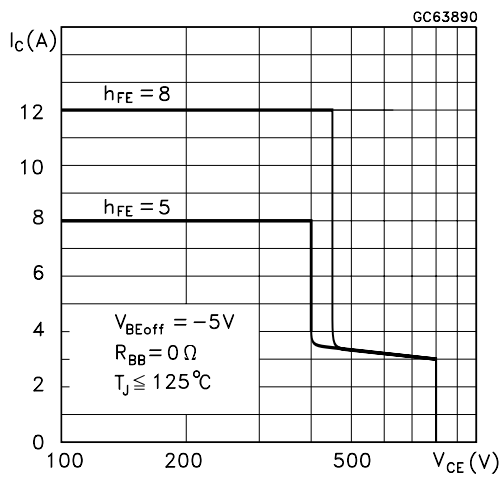
Inductive Fall Time



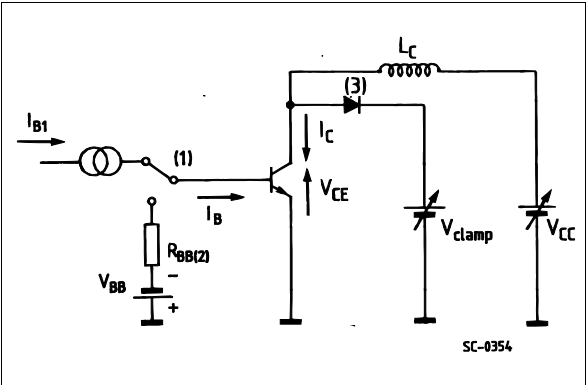
Inductive Storage Time



Reverse Biased SOA



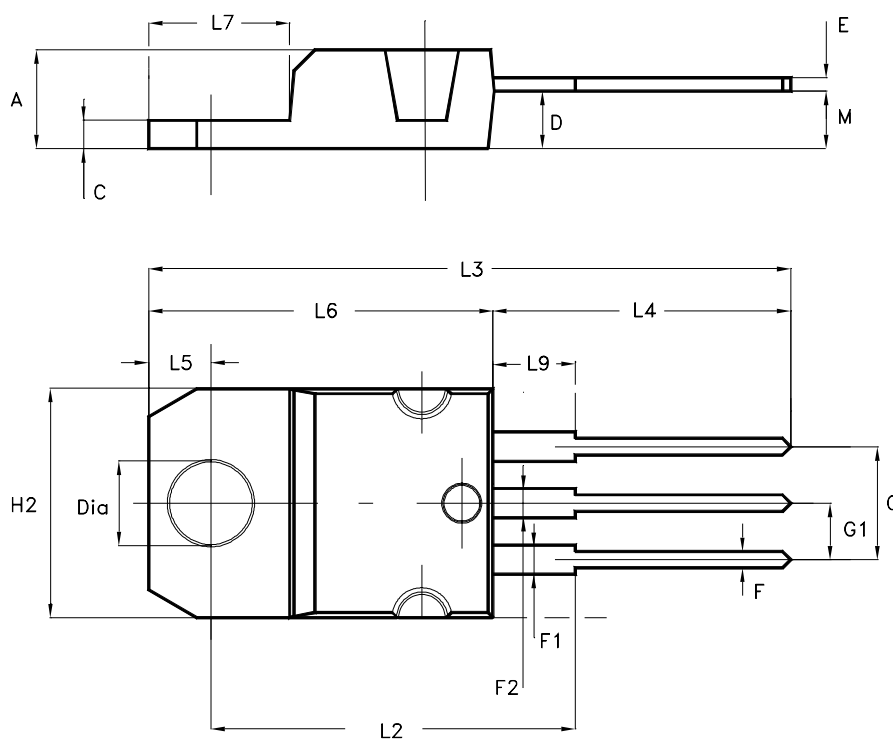
RBSOA and Inductive Load Switching Test Circuit
