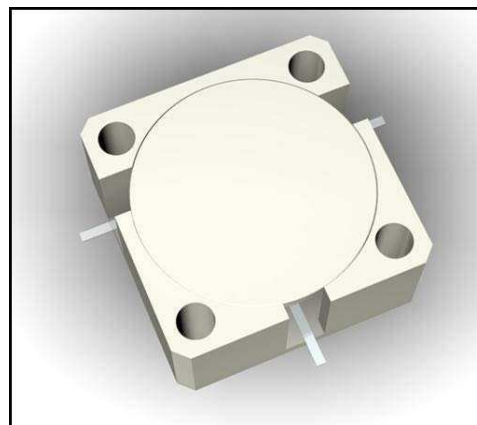

## Description

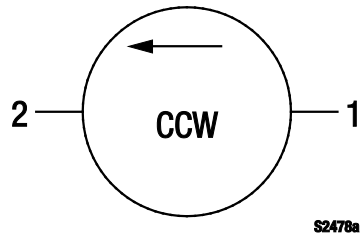
The MAFR-000628-000001 is a single-junction isolator designed for radar and Power Amplifier (PA) applications. It operates over the frequency range of 1200 MHz to 1400 MHz. Insertion loss is less than 0.30 dB over an operating temperature range of  $-40^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $+85^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

The MAFR-000628-000001 comes in an industry-recognized package designed for drop-in assembly.

A block diagram of the MAFR-000628-000001 is shown in Figure 1. The absolute maximum ratings of the MAFR-000628-000001 are provided in Table 1.

Electrical specifications are provided in Table 2. Plating information is shown in Table 3.

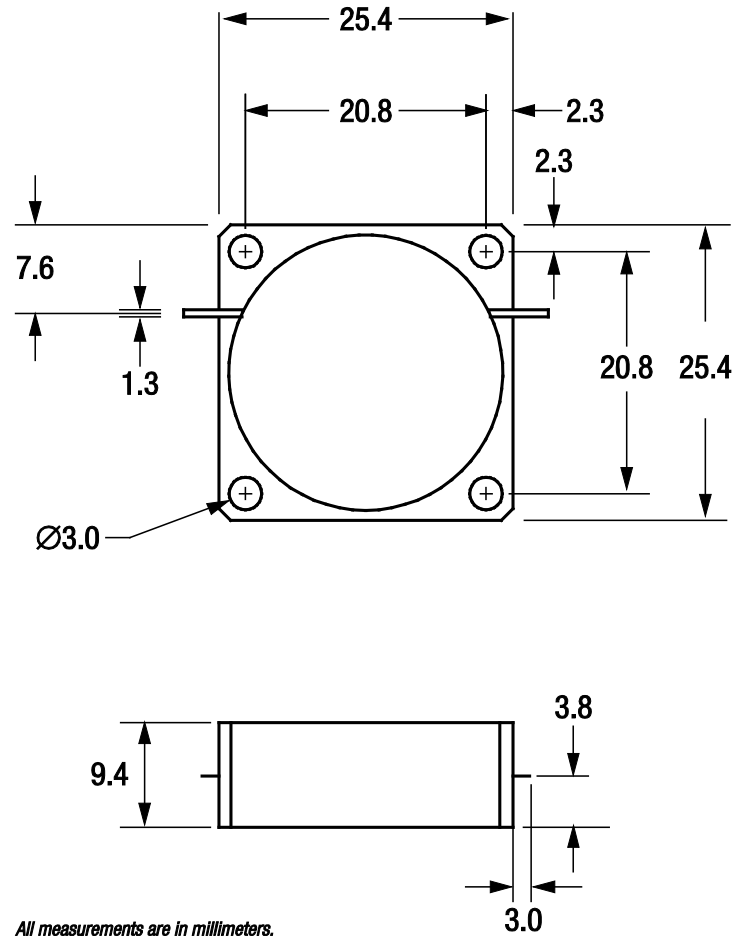
